RE: Proposal for Salt Marsh Bird's-beak establishment at San Elijo Lagoon Ecological Reserve

Dear Proposal Review Committee,

I am writing this letter to express my full support of the project proposed by Conservation Biology Institute and Nature Collective to introduce and establish a population of the federally endangered *Chloropyron maritimum* subsp. *maritimum* (salt marsh bird's-beak) into San Elijo Lagoon Ecological Reserve.

The Chloropyron Outplanting Project (Project) will establish a population of salt marsh bird's-beak in the San Elijo Lagoon Ecological Reserve. This Project will establish a fifth self-sustaining occurrence of salt-marsh bird's-beak (*Chloropyron maritimum* ssp. *maritimum*) in salt marsh habitat to buffer against environmental and demographic stochasticity, promote connectivity to enhance long-term resilience, maintain genetic diversity, and ensure persistence over the long-term.

Potential sites within the Reserve have been identified within the Reserve on both County of San Diego and CDFW land. Restoration activities for the project will include outplanting the seed and then maintaining and monitoring the sites to ensure the population establishes and can sustain itself.
