The City of San Diego (CoSD) Parks and Recreation Department has partnered with the Mission Trails Park Foundation to submit this grant application for the *Mission Trails, San Diego Thornmint Restoration and Enhancement Project*. If the application is chosen for funding the CoSD Parks and Recreation team has committed to provide \$52,025.00 in the form of "In-Kind" services as a match for the life of this five-year grant project. The Parks and Recreation Department also will utilize existing licensing agreements with Mission Trails Park Foundation or issue a Right of Entry (ROE) permit prior to the grant award being finalized.
